

## Reprint Permission

The Perseus Books Group is pleased to announce our transition to the Copyright Clearance Center's Rightslink® service, the most efficient means of securing timely permission for use of Perseus Books Group copyrighted material. Whether your reuse is for book, anthology, proceedings, journal/magazine, newspaper/newsletter, intranet, internet, CD-ROM/DVD/memory stick, thesis/dissertation, photocopy, presentation or email, it can be granted directly through Rightslink.

1. Once you have located your desired title, select the 'Click Here For Copyright Permissions' link to open the following page (turn off your browser's pop-up blocker, if necessary) and select the appropriate Type of Use:

### What if the title I'm seeking does not have a Rightslink link available?

Should you find the title you're looking for but find it does not have a Rightslink "Purchase Permissions" icon, we are most likely not the copyright holder of the extract or the work you wish to use. This is specifically true for paperback reprints (where the hardcover publisher retains all rights), anthologies, illustrations, diagrams and / or other graphics. In all cases, please check the copyright page, acknowledgement page, credits or title page for the correct copyright holder.

Other copyright research sources include the Library of Congress, [Whitakers: Books in Print](#), [WATCH](#) or [COPAC](#). There are also a number of online retailers who offer "search" functionality

which is particularly helpful in isolating the copyright holder. And, of course, you can get your hands on an actual copy of the book. As a general rule, the rightsholder is most often the original (usually hardback) publisher and any correspondence should be addressed accordingly.

**What if the title I'm seeking is not found on the Perseus Books Group website?**

If the title is not on our website – but one of our imprints – the title is most likely out of print and, though still under copyright, not actively sold on the Perseus Books Group site.

Please contact [domestic.rights@perseusbooks.com](mailto:domestic.rights@perseusbooks.com) with the title, author, publisher, and ISBN of the title. Enter “Out of Print title request” in the subject line.

These titles are direct-for-sale to the end user, so it is no longer necessary for the student to purchase an unusable text copy of the book.
